Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third-parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of text sent by your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you.

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.

How Advergame Technologies Private Limited uses cookies

When you use and access the Service, we may place a number of cookies files in your web browser.

We use cookies for the following purposes: to enable certain functions of the Service, to provide analytics, to store your preferences, to enable advertisements delivery, including behavioral advertising.

We use both session and persistent cookies on the Service and we use different types of cookies to run the Service. We use the following cookies on this website, for the following purposes:

- Anonymous analytics cookies
- Advertising cookies
- Third-party cookies

Anonymous analytics cookies:

When you visit our website, software provided by other organisations generate an "anonymous analytics cookie". These cookies tell us whether you have visited the site before. Your browser will tell us if you have these cookies and, if you don't, we generate new ones.

This allows us to track how many individual users we have, and how often they visit the site. These cookies cannot allow us to identify individuals. We use them to gather statistics, for example, the number of visits to a page.

Advertising cookies

These cookies allow us to know whether you've seen a advertisement or a type of advertisement, and how long it is since you've seen it. We also use cookies to help us use targeted advertising. These cookies are anonymous - they store information about what you are looking at on our site, but not about who you are.

Third-party cookies

In addition to our own cookies, we may also use various third-parties cookies to report usage statistics of the Service, deliver advertisements on and through the Service, and so on.

Google cookies

We use Google Analytics to on this website. Google Analytics generates statistical information about website use by using cookies, which are stored on your computer. The information generated relating to the Service is used by Google Analytics to create reports about the use of our websites. Google stores and uses this information. Advergame Technologies Private Limited publishes Google AdSense interest-based advertisements through its Service. These are specified by Google to reflect your interests. To determine this, Google will track your behaviour across the web using cookies. You can opt-out of the AdSense partner network cookie at: http://www.google.com/privacy_ads.html. How do I turn cookies off?

It is usually possible to stop your browser accepting cookies, or to stop it accepting cookies from a website.

Please note, however, that if you delete cookies or refuse to accept them, you might not be able to use all the features we offer, you may not be able to store your preferences, and some of our pages might not display properly.
